

Accessibility settings in Windows 10

1. Select the four-square Start button on your taskbar
2. Click the Settings icon (Cog)
3. Click on 'Ease of Access'

Adjustable features:

- **Display** - change the size of the text and apps and adjust brightness.
- **Cursor & pointer** - change cursor size, colour and thickness.
- **Magnifier** - used to zoom in on parts of your display. You can turn off and on in this section as well as adjust magnification.
- **Colour filters** - makes colours and photos easier to see adding filters.
- **High contracts** - makes text and apps easier to see by using more distinct colours.

- **Narrator** - screen reader function. See Narrator guide.
- **Audio** - use the slider to change the volume of your device. You can also enable visual alerts in this section.
- **Close captions** - can display audio as text. You can also adjust how this is displayed, colour, background, text size etc.
